WELCOME TO THE MOST EXCITING COMMUNITY **PROJECT IN THE HURON VALLEY AREA!**



We began this journey in the Summer of 2016 with the goal of building a safe, long-lasting, beautiful bike and skate park in Milford. In a short span of time, we have completed all of the due diligence to break ground, including:

- Partnered with the Village of Milford and the Milford Village Parks & Recreation Department to secure buildable land adjacent to the Police Station
- Raised almost \$36,000 with small donations to cover land survey work, as well as pay for the Design & Planning Phase with a world-class skatepark design build firm, Spohn Ranch
- Garnered interest from one of Michigan's most successful community development matching-funds programs
- Tony Hawk, the world's most famous skateboarder, has offered to make an appearance to skate our new park

In other words - we're ready to go! We just need your help. But we also know how busy our local businesses and community members are. 4 REASONS WHY YOU SHOULD CONSIDER CONTRIBUTING



SAFETY

According to the American Academy of Pediatrics, the vast majority of major injuries and fatalities relative to skateboarding and riding scooters involve a motor vehicle. Right now, kids in our local area do not have a safe place to ride a skateboard, scooter or BMX bike. We can change that, together.



LOCAL BUSINESSES

While skateboarders enjoy looking for "features" to skate (e.g. curbs, ledges, handrails, etc.) out in "the wild," our skatepark design replicates those features, which will decrease the instances of kids skating in unauthorized areas. And as parents ourselves, it also allows all of us to further enforce the rules, specifically governing our downtown district.





We aren't the first group with the idea of building a skatepark in Milford. From 2005 to around 2009 a different group worked hard to raise funds. Their effort stalled after an unsuccessful attempt to pass a millage for the remainder of the funding. However, around \$35,000 of their remaining funds are held in trust, marked specifically for the maintenance of any future skatepark built in the Huron Valley area. So you can feel great that, not only are we building a world-class, long-lasting concrete park, but one that comes with funds to ensure it will be maintained for future generations.

SIGNIFICANT RECOGNITION OF YOUR BUSINESS



From perpetual sponsorships that are literally built-into the concrete of the park itself, to local press coverage, to possible participation in state-funded matching programs, you can expect a significant level of awareness generated for your business. Not to mention, possible spotlight recognition at the ribbon cutting with Tony Hawk.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

During the Summer of 2017, Spohn Ranch visited Milford and conducted a fun, highly interactive focus group with around 30 kids, ages 6 to 19 years old. The result of their feedback, as well as input from several public hearings, is a "plaza-style" park, with integrated garden areas and a design that utilizes the natural topography.
